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#### **Brief summary**

In this document it is presented the digital platforms that enable virtual collaboration within each I-R&Di network (confidential) and dissemination of the main outputs of the project to the general public, as well as to the internal and external stakeholders who aim to get involved in the project (public): MS Teams and the project website.

MS Teams was selected for internal collaboration because it is a ready-made, welldemonstrated solution to which all project members already had access to at their institutions, ensuring a quick start of WP4 work and effective communication and co-creation by our crossborder team.

On the other hand, the eudres.com website is a living platform that will undergo continuous updates and upgrades, responding to the needs of the project as they arise (during and after this 3-years funding period). The next upgrade to the website was commissioned by the WP4 and aims to streamline and enhance our ability to reach and attract internal and external stakehoders to collaborate in our community-based (citizen science) research projects.





#### 1. E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> internal workspace

MS teams has been used since the beginning of the project as a collaborative workspace where all researchers, as well as the WP4 coordination team, share documents and hold meetings. The project's Team is hosted by STPUAS MS Teams. Our channel is named "WP4 – Researchers" and it is currently organized into 10 main folders (see Fig. 1), of which the first three are mostly managed by the 3 research networks, fed with files that result from their ongoing work and it contains the corresponding banks of researchers, stakeholders and students. The other folders contain materials that support the work of the researchers and are mostly fed by the WP4 coordination.

#### 2. E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> Website

The initial release of the E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> website<sup>1</sup> (the one that is currently online) is a static and simpler version of what we will have implemented in the medium-term. Together with the E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> presence in the social networks (Facebook, LinkedIn and Instagram), it served the main purpose of starting to raise awareness of the project among internal and external stakeholders<sup>2</sup>, as well as general public, in its initial stages.

The new features that are being introduced to the website, by the agency commissioned by the Project Coordinators at STPUAS, were drafted by the WP4 Team, with the main purpose

of supporting engagement and communications with both internal and external stakeholders. Besides extending the website's capacity for dissemination of more specific content related with the different work packages, it will also allow to automatically feed the WP4 databases (banks of researchers, stakeholders, challenges and students/curricular units) because it will give the possibility to those different actors to register themselves and their research/academic profiles (for researchers, curricular units' coordinators and students) or challenges/problems (stakeholders and citizens/citizen scientists).

The new version of the website with these features incorporated will be online in August 2021.

#### Technical specifications of the new features being added to the website

The Content Management System (CMS) used for eudres.eu website is called Statamic. It is a very flexible Laravel + Git powered CMS, offering numerous modern functions and is a future-proof system for the intended website application. Here are a few features and benefits of Statamic provided by the Developers' Team:

#### Summary:

- Excellent page speed and SEO;
- Complete freedom of design and functions for the developers;
- Intuitive user interface in the control panel (for editors);
- The control panel offers great collaboration possibilities for editors (also for large teams), such as role-dependent permissions for the release of content, versioning, filtering and sorting of content, live preview, etc;
- Lean installation with maximum flexibility;
- Strong automation options and interface themes;
- Can be operated as a headless CMS.

#### Long version:

User interface for editors:

- Can be tailored exactly to the needs of clients and is not limited by the system;
- No unnecessarily complex user interface only the information that is really relevant is visible.

File-based CMS and versioning via Git:

- Easy to use without a database and very good versioning (every comment is versioned);
- Very good performance, as the database is not "cluttered" by backups.

Developer-friendly:

- Any web developer who is familiar with the Statamic documentation can make changes to the website, extend it, etc. within a short time;
- Generally easy to extend, especially with regard to interfaces and individual functions;
- Can be equipped with a database if required (which we would not recommend, as this makes versioning [see above] more difficult);

Complete freedom of design:

- Everything that is possible on the web can be implemented in the frontend of websites with Statamic;
- No limitations due to the system or theme.

Statamic is a REAL content management system:


- It is a CMS that can be used not only for websites;
- Can be operated as a headless CMS and is therefore future-proof;
- Can easily juggle data out-of-the-box (e.g. display of content [e.g. events] in list views, which can be searched, sorted and filtered).



- The researcher can fill all areas except the two last ones (that appear in lighter colours).
- After filling this form, a new line is automatically generated at the bank of researchers (imports data from this form) and the corresponding CV can be accessed by anyone (permission 2 or 3) who clicks the line (sees the same template as the "wall of fame" one.
- I-R&D network leaders (permission 3) can click at the Bank of Researcher line and see the previous form, with no possibility to change the already introduced data, but with the "invited to join the following I-R&D group " active. If they are interested in this researcher, they shall put a cross in the corresponding I-R&D network.
- A researcher can be selected by more than one line. Each time he/her are selected, receive a notification by e-mail, asking to come and accept or reject. When entering this page after this, the last button "Research Consent" is active (but only the groups he was invited to). When accepting one, his line disappears at the "bank or researchers" ans his photo appears at the corresponding Wall of Fame (and his/her photo becomes linked to his/her CV, as all the other researches that were already there.


