## Brief summary

On 23 and 24 September 2021, E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> hosted its first-ever Hackathon titled "Hack2Change". The virtual event took place under the motto "Smart & Sustainable Regions" and strongly integrated local stakeholders of all E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> regions. Within the framework of the international hackathon, teams of students, interested employees of the universities participating in E<sup>3</sup>UDRES<sup>2</sup> or external persons were able to work on challenges for 36 hours, which were submitted by regional stakeholders. Three teams with the most promising solutions were chosen by a jury as the winning teams.

The 36-hour event was strongly advertised in advance via social media and also covered live on Facebook and Instagram.
