1 Background and description of the work package

During the first two years of its operation, E³UDRES² has been acting as an Engaged University by initiating a lively exchange with diverse social target groups of a broad public. This was achieved, during the first year, with the establishment and promotion of various activities for students of different levels of education, as well as participation opportunities for citizens and stakeholders. The learnings, good practices, and challenges faced during public outreach efforts were taken into consideration in the continuation of the communication and dissemination activities, as well as visibility of the alliance and its European values.

On the second year of operation of the E³UDRES² alliance, WP6 kept public engagement its highest priority, with the establishment and support of various new activities and opportunities for students, citizens, and stakeholders to participate in co-ideating and co-creating the future of European higher entrepreneurial education, as well as high quality research processes by means of citizen science. WP6 has continuously supported other WPs in the dissemination of activities and research results, while at the same time has made outstanding efforts on the sustainability of the alliance. This annual report outlines the achievements of E³UDRES² during the second project year (M13-M24).

2 Co-Creation of a knowledge exchange strategy (T 6.1)

During the second year, E³UDRES² has successfully approached and actively interacted with various target groups, including regional stakeholders, citizens, students, internal staff, and regional and European government. Those interactions were achieved through various online and onsite events, which are comprehensively listed below.

2.1 Europe-wide outreach

Meeting of French Minister with all European University Alliances

On 15 November 2021, the French Minister of Higher Education, Research, and Innovation, met with representatives from all 41 European University Alliances to discuss the further development of the European Higher Education Area. . <u>*Read more here*</u>



E³UDRES² @ Forum of Universities for the Future of Europe

On January 25 and 26, 2022, the "Forum of Universities for the Future of Europe" took place as a virtual event. The event brought together representatives of European Universities, the EU Commission, and various European higher education institutions. The participants had the opportunity to discuss and exchange ideas about the future role of higher education institutions in Europe, especially in the light of the European higher education strategy. *Read more here*

On 27 January 2022, the GRASP Network hosted an online symposium on the "Future of Education". The event dealt with different questions concerning "The Future of Work, Life and Education" and discussed them by inviting various keynote speakers and roundtable guests. On 3 and 4 March 2022, more than 250 students from all over Europe met in Strasbourg to finalize their work on policy recommendations for the Institutions of the European Union. All participating students came from institutions that are part of an of European University Alliances. The two-day event aimed to give a voice to the European students to express their opinions, as well as foster the participation of students within European University Alliances. A collaborative meeting between representatives of MATE and guests form HAS Hogeschool, Netherlands, was held in the premises of MATE on the 4th of July, 2022. The meeting was held in order to establish an official collaboration between the two institutions in the near future. Part of the discussions included the activities of E³UDRES² and how Dutch schools could potentially collaborate on that. Further discussions were held online with 4 participants from Netherlands.

E³UDRES² supports Startup Village Initiative

On 6 September 2022, E³UDRES² representatives attended the Startup OLÉ 2022 - a tech-event connecting startups. The event was an impressive showcase of European upcoming businesses and offered the opportunity to exchange ideas with EU-commissioner E³UDRES² together with five other European University Alliances (eut+, UNIgreen, EBU, EU Green, and Invest) delivered a Vision Statement to EU-Commissioner to express support for the Startup Village Initiative launched by the EU. <u>Read more here</u>

E³UDRES² at the 32nd Annual EAIE Conference and Exhibition in Barcelona

The 32nd Annual EAIE – European Association for International Education Conference and Exhibition, took place between 13–16 September 2022 in Barcelona, Spain. During the Europe's largest international education event of the year, E³UDRES² was promoted by the participating partners STPUAS, UPT, UCLL, MATE, as well as two of Alliance's new associated partners HFD, and SAXION. All E³UDRES² alliance members had appointed meetings with academic and non-academic professionals with best practices and workable solutions to internationalization challenges. E³UDRES² was presented as a valuable alliance for the key stakeholder organizations and institutions, promoting the interests in advanced international higher education. *Read more here*

2.2 Stakeholder engagement

Regional Stakeholder Workshops

During the second year, E³UDRES² has been very active with engaging and involving stakeholders in the alliance's educational and research processes. WP2 has conducted a series of Regional Stakeholder Workshops where external stakeholders shared their visions on the Future University. Second E³UDRES² Research Living Labs

From May 2nd to 6th 2022, IPS hosted the 2nd edition of the Research Living Labs, dedicated to Research and Development (R&D). Promoted under the E³UDRES² alliance, the event, which involved representatives from all six E³UDRES² partner institutions, featured sessions open to the public and others in which researchers worked on developing R&D projects together with stakeholders, citizens and students. Research living labs are primarily developed and organized by WP4, and WP6 assisted with the dissemination and coverage of the event *Read more here*.



International Engagement Circus

From April 26th to 28th 2022, the first E³UDRES² International Engagement Circus took place in Hasselt, in the premises of UCLL. The event was organized by WP3 and it aimed to bring staff from all different E³UDRES² Work Packages together with students and external stakeholders to nurture our E³UDRES² alliances, tackle the topic of on- and offboarding and strengthen the alliances with our external stakeholders in innovative cocreation spaces in the area of Hasselt. 2.3 Open Seminars

Shaping Together #6 - Micro-credentials and their importance for European Universities

On March 23rd 2022, the 6th edition of the webinar series #shapingtogether on the topic "Microcredentials and their importance for European Universities" took place online, organized by UPT. This webinar was dedicated to open education and all actors in the field of education, with the main purpose of promoting the ideas of entrepreneurship and university innovation and the strategic planning of future universities. The webinar was moderated by a UPT Staff Member, while 2 STPUAS staff members participated as speakers *Read more here*

Online Peer Consulting Sessions for Key Innovation Leaders at the Universities

On the 28th of March 2022, the online peer consulting sessions took place, with an objective to generate solutions for specific challenge-based activities and the experience of the participants involved, while also generating general ideas for entrepreneurial and innovative universities. This event was organized by UPT.

Entrepreneurship conference in medicine

On the 31st of March 2022, the entrepreneurial conference in medicine took place online. The objectives of this conference was to define the place, role and status of the University of the Future in the perspective of 2030, as well as to strengthen their role as a driving force for the development of Smart and Sustainable European Regions by promoting innovation in education, research, technology transfer and knowledge. Let's Build Together #10 - Technical Universities in Romania - European Universities

On the 20th of April 2022, the webinar in the "Build Together" series took place and was dedicated to European University alliances with the involvement of the Romanian Alliance of Technical Universities. Rectors of institutions technical higher education, but also representatives from technical universities from Romania, discussed about European multi-campuses, global innovation, promotion of education, research and innovation at regional and European level. *Read more here*

International Workshop on Digital Transformation

On 16 June 2022, UPT together with <u>Erasmus + MODE-IT</u> organized the first edition of the *International workshop on Digital transformation - Experiences in digital education.* The workshop was addressed to students from all levels of education, university staff, and the general public. <u>Read more here</u>.

2.4 Communication strategy

On the 30th of September 2022 the first edition of a communication strategy for the E³UDRES² alliance was published and disseminated across the alliance. The document, entitled "E³UDRES² Handbook of Communication", is intended for every person involved in E³UDRES²



and its primary objective is to provide a general introduction to E³UDRES², its mission, structure, and function of various boards, WPs and groups. Most importantly, however, this handbook aims to define and visualize communication patterns and information flows within the alliance. In addition, it presents various tools for knowledge and technology transfer to all members of society, as well as the dissemination of not only the various events generated by E³UDRES², but also the overall structure and vision of the alliance, while highlighting the novelty and importance of European Universities. The E³UDRES² Handbook of Communication was created by the Communication Strategy task force, which consisted of members of WP6. <u>Read more here</u>

3 Science Engagement (T 6.2)

During the second year of E³UDRES² a lot of science engagement activities were on-going aiming at students of all levels of education, as well as the general public. The Alliance has contributed to science communication and science engagement both as across-campus, as well as on a regional level.

3.1 Student-centred activities

I Living Labs

The E³UDRES² I Living Labs started with a first round in the winter semester of 2021/22. From October to December, 12 international teams of students were working for six weeks on challenges related to Artificial Intelligence, Circular Economy and Wellbeing. During this time, they are guided by Educational Entrepreneurs and stakeholders. On 15 December 2021 the Showdown of the first I Living Labs took place online where all teams presented their solutions in a short video pitch. In the summer semester of 2022, the I Living Labs went into the second round and grew bigger with 16 international teams engaging with solutions for our regions. The showdown of the second round took place online on 09 May 2022. This format is very popular with students and one of the flagships of E³UDRES² student activities. WP6 has supported the organization of the I Living Labs with establishing various promotional material (i.e. flyers, brochures, videos, posters, postcards), as well as a comprehensive coverage of the registration openings and showdowns through social media posts and/or press releases. E³UDRES² Bootcamp

The first E³UDRES² bootcamp took place between 04-08 July 2022 in the Austrian Alps. 24 students from seven E³UDRES² partner institutions were selected to join the bootcamp and work in four different teams on challenges focussing on "The new sustainable future campus". During the intensive week, the students worked in small international and interdisciplinary groups on a challenge and were guided by mentors and experts. They met different stakeholders from the region and an interactive social program rounded off the experience of the bootcamp. WP6 established the entire coverage of the on the E³UDRES² social media channels and news articles. The event was also covered by regional media (newspaper article and radio shows). *Read more here.*

Future Students Workshop

On 24 February 2022, the first Future Students Workshop took place online. 16 pupils from eight different schools in Latvia, Hungary, Austria, and Portugal expressed their opinion and expectations on Future Universities and discussed with experts. The event also included three round table discussions led by E³UDRES² researchers focussing on the three main research topics within E³UDRES²: circular economy, wellbeing and active aging and human contribution



to artificial intelligence. The students' ideas will be further incorporated into the mission of E³UDRES² to create a blueprint for Future Universities. The workshop was developed and organized by WP6 and WP2, in an attempt to reach students from various levels of education, promote E³UDRES² and the values of European University Alliances. <u>Read more here.</u>

3.2 Science promotion and communication

E³UDRES² Science Pub Quiz

The second year of E³UDRES² was also marked by the initiation of the E³UDRES² Science Pub Quiz. This event was held for the first time on 02 December 2021 as an online event. It took place via a YouTube live stream. In total, 14 international teams were competing by answering questions about Artificial Intelligence, sustainability, the E³UDRES² European University Alliance and many more. The quiz was open to the public and was advertised on social media as well as on the E³UDRES² websites and campuses. It attracted E³UDRES² staff members, students and stakeholders, who participated in the 60-minute-long event. Due to the great success, a second online event took place on 03 February 2022 attracting 21 teams in total. The Pub Quiz is a great format to showcase science and research happening at the E³UDRES² institutions whilst entertaining at the same time. <u>Read</u> <u>more here.</u>

Change cornEr seminars

Another science communication and outreach activity came from the <u>Change cornEr</u>, the internal E³UDRES² project of the circular economy research group. In an attempt to promote their research and to raise awareness on circular economy, the Change corner members organized lectures and seminars in the premises of IPS, STUPAS, UCLL, and UPT. In addition, a physical Change cornEr was set up in the campus of STPUAS, where students and staff can participate in polls and surveys. WP6 has continuously assisted the research group with the dissemination of the lectures and seminars, as well as with the content of the physical Change cornEr, which is updated regularly *Read more here*.

3.3 Science outreach events

International Week at ViA

From 12 to 16 April 2022 ViA hosted the International Week with a special focus on the E³UDRES² alliance. Members from all E³UDRES² partner institutions travelled to Latvia to participate in the event where students, educators and researchers were working on the "Future University. Connecting Learners, Educators, Researchers and Innovators". The week was a great opportunity to build up new collaborations, network with partners from different universities and exchange on the newest research results. The event was covered on social media and a press release was published. At the same time the scientific conference "Society. Technology. Solutions." also took place in the premises of ViA, which aimed to contribute to the synergy between society, technologies, and security by looking deeper in thematic fields related to future knowledge-society, knowledge sharing and innovation, sustainable development, and security related to digital transformation. Lange Nacht der Forschung (Long Night of Research)

On 20 May 2022 the "Long Night of Research" took place on-site for the first time after the beginning of the pandemic. During this Austrian-wide event, universities and research institutions open their doors to the public to showcase their research and facilities. At STPUAS this event was combined with the opening of the new campus. The general public experienced research activities at 25 hands-on stations spread over the entire campus and in the research



labs. The program was completed by 6 lectures, a podium discussion and guided tours, and rounded off by an evening program. E³UDRES² was represented with an interactive booth with activities for all age-groups. In total, over 700 visitors came to the campus to learn more about the research at STPUAS. The event was promoted nationally and E³UDRES² activities were covered on social media channels and on the E³UDRES² website. <u>*Read more here.*</u>

European Researchers' Night

Three E³UDRES² partners applied for the funding of the European Researchers' Night 2022&2023. IPS applied in collaboration with 3 HEIs, 1 City Council, 2 Research Organisations, 1 company and 11 Non-Governmental Organisations (Title: SOUTHSIDE OF SCIENCE). ViA applied in collaboration with other universities and institutes from Latvia (Acronym: NaktsLV). STPUAS applied in collaboration with a research institute (acronym: LiS-Dig).

The application of STPUAS was successful. Together with their partner acib (Austrian Centre for Industrial Biotechnology) they organised the outreach event around the topic of "Life is Science in a Digital World" (LiS-Dig). The main location of LiS-Dig was the campus of STPUAS with a few activities happening in the city of Graz. The event was divided in two parts. In the morning, eight different school workshops were offered for school classes upon registration. In the afternoon and evening, 41 activities (hands-on stations, lectures, quizzes, live shows, etc.) took place. One of the highlights of the event was the "Spotlight on Europe" corner presenting projects from MSCA researchers and from the E³UDRES² alliance. In total, 5 hands-on stations gave an insight into the European University itself, as well as their research projects. In the evening, the first E³UDRES² pub quiz took place on site at the premises of STPUAS. *Read more here*.

Even though the applications of IPS and ViA were not successful, both universities organised outreach events on the date of the European Researchers' Night to participate in the European-wide day of science and to showcase E³UDRES². MATE also joined the European-wide event and showcased E³UDRES² on all participating MATE campuses during an event on the day of the European Researchers' Night.

4 Open Access - Open Science (T6.3)

During the second year, WP6 has taken action to establish an Open Science Strategy. In March 2022, a task force, including researchers, communication specialists, and librarians from all partner institutions came together in order to develop a E³UDRES² wide document on Open Access and Open Science strategies. The working document will be soon presented to the Board of Coordinators and will be distributed across the alliance within the third year of E³UDRES².

5 E³UDRES² Campus Media (T 6.4)

During the second year, E^3UDRES^2 has continued to utilize the media facilities of their institutions. As a result, the alliance generated a variety of content for the promotion of E^3UDRES^2 activities and vision.

5.1 Promotion of I Living Labs

6 Annual Conferences and Workshops (T 6.5)

After the successful organization of the E³UDRES² Opening Conference, which took place in the first year of the E³UDRES² (see deliverable D6.1), the alliance has maintained the high level of involvement of all colleagues and WPs.

Specifically, from 18 - 20 October 2021, several staff members from the partner universities of E³UDRES² visited STPUAS for the very first on-site meeting. In addition to many personal meetings and informal conversations, the new STPUAS campus was presented to the international guests. This long-awaited meeting offered the various E³UDRES² Boards and working groups ideal conditions to review the already completed first year of the Alliance and to make long-term plans. *Read more here.*

In addition, from 6-8 July 2022, STPUAS hosted the very first E³UDRES² Strategy Forum, also on-site. The event offered networking sessions and discussions on the E³UDRES² achievements and various challenges. WP6 has continuously presented the results of the above-mentioned events by actively publishing social media posts and articles on the E³UDRES² website, as well as the websites of all partner institutions.


Furthermore, research activities from the E³UDRES² research network about circular economy were also disseminated in lectures and seminars. UCLL organised a <u>ChangeCornEr Lunchlecture</u> series from 26 October 2021 to 17 Mai 2022 about the topic of Circular Economy containing 5 lectures in total. IPS organised an open lecture on Circular Economy which is now available <u>online</u> and a seminar of Circular Economy in the Setubal region on 11 January 2022.



8 Corporate Identity and Marketing (T 6.7)

The establishment of a recognizable corporate identity constitutes an already fulfilled task, with the establishment of a brand book, logo, and various graphics already reported in deliverable D6.1.

During the second year, E³UDRES² has continuously attempted to strengthen the alliance's corporate identity with the creation of posters and merchandize. Furthermore, with the addition of three more associated-partner-HEIs (i.e., HFD, SAXION, and JAMK), which will be full partners in the second round of E³UDRES², WP6 has updated some original graphs (i.e. the map and connecting network of partner institutions below, which now includes the three new associated partners as well).


9 E³UDRES² Online (T 6.6)

9.1 Website

Launched back in February 2021, the E³UDRES² website (\rightarrow www.eudres.eu) has continued to be the main source of information for internal and external parties concerning E³UDRES². As planned, the content of the website is extended continuously, also turning the website more and more into a digital platform for sharing information, interaction, and initiating collaboration. The E³UDRES² website is also the main point of contact for students (and others interested in participating in E³UDRES² activities) to get information about upcoming E³UDRES² events, participation requirements and registration.

In the period of time from October 2021 to September 2022, the E³UDRES² website was visited by 4.800 users worldwide with an average interaction time on the site of 3 minutes. The website accumulated 95.000 views in this time period.

In 2022, the E³UDRES² website has received various important updates, which include among others:

E³UDRES² Bank of Challenges

A database of real-life challenges that were submitted by (local) stakeholders, such as business owners, regional authorities, or university staff. 

In summer 2022, the E³UDRES² website received a visual update, which also included the introduction of a calendar showcasing upcoming events, a simpler, more intuitive structure of the news section, and more visually strong page headers. This was again implemented in collaboration with the Austrian agency *dryven* (formerly known as DDM), which has maintained the technical side of the website since the beginning, and also created the original E³UDRES² brand book.


In the report timeframe (Oct 2021 – Sept 2022), 42 news articles were published on the $E^{3}UDRES^{2}$ website, showcasing not only the engagement and activities of the alliance, but also highlighting the growing impact $E^{3}UDRES^{2}$ has on institutional events and activities.



After launching E³UDRES² profiles on *Instagram*, *Facebook*, *LinkedIn*, *YouTube* in early 2021 (see deliverable D6.1), the alliance has continued to systemize its content scheme, making sure followers are able to not only get insights into general E³UDRES² topics, such as events, milestones and new activities, but also institutional information. While for example 69 posts were published on the E³UDRES² Instagram page from January to September 2021, it was possible to increase the amount of content significantly in the period from October 2021 to September 2022, with a total of 110 posts being published. This increased focus and activity on social media not only led to a wider knowledge about E³UDRES², but also increased the follower count of E³UDRES² significantly. In addition, and in an effort to reach out to the scientific community more efficiently, E³UDRES² also created a profile on Twitter.

As the E³UDRES² Alliance consists of several partnering institutions, and this shall also be represented on the E³UDRES² social media channels, all profiles are maintained by admins from each partnering institution, enabling E³UDRES² to showcase real insights into also institutional activities. In addition, through frequently tagging the individual partnering institutions, the E³UDRES² content also gets reposted on institutional channels, further improving the reach of the E³UDRES² content, especially to the local student communities.



At present, E³UDRES² publishes content on Facebook, Instagram, and LinkedIn very frequently (at least 2x/week), with the quantity of content increasing around important events. Activities such as the E³UDRES² Bootcamp, the celebratory event welcoming HFD and SAXION to the E³UDRES² alliance, or the E³UDRES² Hackathon were thoroughly covered on social media, especially via Instagram and Facebook Stories. Collectively, E³UDRES² has created 110 Instagram posts, 128 Facebook posts, 36 Tweets (starting from March 2022), and 77 LinkedIn posts, including shared posts/retweets, in the timeframe of October 2021 to September 2022, as well as multiple stories to promote upcoming and ongoing events during the second year. E³UDRES² has also uploaded 18 publicly available YouTube videos in that timeframe.

The main aim of the E³UDRES² Social media channels is to increase visibility of the alliance and of its activities, inform anyone interested about participation opportunities, attract users to join future E³UDRES² events, and showcase the achievements of the alliance. Until September 2022, E³UDRES² managed to organically acquire a total of 461 followers on LinkedIn (+312 compared to last report period), 404 followers (+254 compared to last report period) on Instagram, and 405 followers (+265 compared to last report period) on Facebook. After the launch of the E³UDRES² Twitter profile in March 2022, @eudres_alliance was followed by 120 users up until September 2022.

Compared to the last reporting period, the visibility of E³UDRES² content across Facebook and Instagram has improved significantly. Again, the E³UDRES² Facebook page seems to have reached the largest audience, with a total of 33.839 people having seen content published by E³UDRES². This is an increase of 15.873 compared to the last reporting period. The same is true for the E³UDRES² Instagram presence, where the increase amounted to an additional 4.575 individual users.

For the upcoming reporting period, E³UDRES² will continue to follow a consistent content scheme, with a focus on a unified, clearly recognizable design image and branding.



10 Public Relations (T 6.9)

E³UDRES² has been strongly focusing on public relations on a regional, as well as international level. Within the second year the alliance has been presented in 15 press releases and 15 articles. These publications highlighted all important events that took place within the second year such as the I Living Labs, the E³UDRES² Bootcamp and the welcoming of new associate partners. An analytical table with links to every article and press release can be found in the *Appendix*.

STPUAS concluded a service contract with an external PR agency (PR&D) to prepare international press releases. In the second year of E³UDRES², a total of 4 press releases were published by the agency, which were spread on Austrian and European Level to communicate the E³UDRES² idea on a broader level.

11 Internal Communication (T 6.10)

To guarantee that E³UDRES² and its activities are well-known and visible across the alliance's mega-campus, E³UDRES² ensured that all actions and related issues are communicated through the individual channels of all partner institutions. Precisely, all alliance members have continuously presented E³UDRES² and its activities via their institutions' websites, as well as their newsletters and social media platforms. The visibility of the alliance has been strengthening across the campuses of all partners with the creations of posters and panels, which are placed in distinct areas of each campus, as well as the establishment of various kinds of merchandizing, always following the sustainable vision of the alliance.

In order to communicate E³UDRES² within their community some partner institutions have created various dissemination events. In October 2021 IPS disseminated E³UDRES² in their internal conference entitled "Ciência à Conversa" where the scientific work developed in the three E³UDRES² research networks was presented. The event was organized by UAIIDE, IPS's innovation and research office, in collaboration with WP6 and WP4, demonstrating a gradual presence of the theme within the offices and channels of the institution itself (*link*). MATE has disseminated E³UDRES² among their international students during their orientation week, as well as larger events such as the International Dinner and the National Poetry Day. Similarly, UCLL also made E³UDRES² known to their new students during their campus tours and various introductory seminars. IPS made available an E³UDRES² website, in Portuguese, which intends to locally reinforce the communication already presented through the E³UDRES² website.

The communication within E³UDRES² is constantly being optimized. During the second year, new channels have been introduced in MS Teams for announcements that regard the entire alliance. In addition, WP6 established an internal newsletter entitled "The E³UDRES² Times", which is disseminated to all members of the alliance, including the executive and advisory board. In the third year, the E³UDRES² Newsletter will be open for everyone. Lastly, this year E³UDRES² established big town hall meetings, entitled "E³UDRES² Update" where the big strategic news and developments of the alliance are announced and discussed. So far, two E³UDRES² update events have been organized, and they will be more frequent in the third year of the project.

12 Long-term strategy for sustainability of the alliance (T 6.11)

This first three years of E³UDRES² Erasmus+ funding is the kick-off for establishing a longterm intensive collaboration between the participating partners. Jointly with other WPs, a longterm strategy for the sustainability of the alliance will be developed. However, the main focus



in the first year of collaboration was to establish current network, the internal processes and collaboration culture, first successful proposals for further funding were handed in.

In the second year, E³UDRES² made already quite good progress in broadening and consolidating the E³UDRES² network. Additional proposals for European funded project were handed in, three new proposals were approved, and one additional project has started within the reporting period.

- Provide expertise and resources to turn ideas into value for smart and sustainable European regions

E.I.N.S is supported by EIT InnoEnergy, coordinated by RawMaterials and Co-funded by the European Union. The project has started on 1 October 2021. 12.3 New E³UDRES² partners

In project year 2, the E³UDRES³ alliance also started to expand its network by select candidates which will join the alliance in the next phase as full partners.

After a competitive selection process, including presentations, hearings and benchmarking the following three higher education institutions were selected as candidates for full partners:

- SAXION: Saxion University of Applied Sciences (The Netherlands)
- HFD: Fulda University of Applied Science (Germany)
- JAMK: Jyväskylä University of Applied Sciences (Finland)

The expansion of the E³UDRES² alliance is part of the long-term strategy for sustainability of the alliance. Including new (full) partners will lead to a broadening of the experience, developing of a critical mass of experts and a wider variety of offers and opportunities for students and staff.

13 Sustainable platform-oriented business models

In project year 2, the alliance started to discuss further opportunities of collaboration beyond the initial Erasmus+ funding phase. Beside first discussions on future governance model and legal entity opportunities, the discussion also included ideas on a sustainable business model.

As already described in 12, since the start of the alliance in October 2020, several additional third party funded project were successfully approved. This is one major step towards a sustainable platform-oriented business model. Those additionally funded projects not only include the existing full partners of the E³UDRES² alliance, but also new partners (academic and non-academic) to not only broaden the alliances network but also to broaden the alliances' expertise. This supports the idea of a platform-oriented business model, which focusses on including non-alliance partners, various stakeholders, manage their relationships and enable direct interactions.

14 Conclusions and Future objectives

Within the second project year of E³UDRES², WP6 has continued its achievements in the areas of dissemination, internal communication, and public engagement but also in the sustainability of the alliance. E³UDRES² is continuing to be constantly presented in articles and press releases. The presence of E³UDRES² on social media has also been strengthened and with the rising numbers of followers/subscribers and the ever-growing engagement. WP6 has kept the dissemination of the alliance's activities in close collaboration with other WPs and with their assistance the internal communication of the alliance is constantly being optimized.

The goals of WP6 the third year is to optimize the visibility of E³UDRES² in all partner institutions, with the development of common promotional materials and merchandize. In addition, WP6 is seeking to create a more regularly published external Newsletter, as well as more frequent town-hall meetings. Even though there have already been attempts for promotion of multilingualism (see chapter 5), WP6 will strengthen this part of our international collaboration and further promote the values of a European collaboration. In addition, stronger actions towards citizens science will be attempted, in collaboration with WP4, and as more and more scientific results are being published, WP6 is seeking to strengthen the overall science communication of the alliance.
