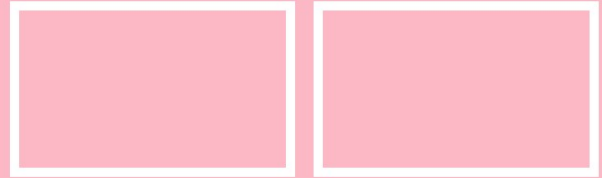


# CLASSIC I LIVING LAB



## Specifics of this format

You take on a challenge provided by an entrepreneur, (non-profit) organisation or local government. Together with them and your transdisciplinary team, you will work on a real-life solution. You get the opportunity to use your knowledge and interest in an international setting from home.

## Mobility & Locations

This format takes place fully online, there is vno mobility or travels included.

## Team assembly

The teams are built according to the theme you choose. Depending on the registrations, your team will be formed with students from max. 6 different universities.

## Schedule

You'll start with 2 weeks of ONBOARDING. There is an online Kick-Off Show, and you and your teammates have the opportunity to get to know each other. In the following 8 weeks, you will work together on your challenge. You'll meet with your team according to the agreements of your I Living Lab. Note that there are 2 weeks of Easter holiday included. The last 2 weeks will be OFF-BOARDING.

## **Conditions for passing a Classic I Living Lab**

In order to get a positive grading for your I Living Lab, you need to attend at least 80% of the online meetings. Illness and certain family circumstances are reasons for which a legitimate absence applies. This must always be supported by an attestation.
