BIOGRAPHY	<p>Professor István Szabó graduated with outstanding results from Gödöllő University – the predecessor of Szent István University – in 1987 as a mechanical engineer and also as a Russian-Hungarian professional interpreter. As part of his training program he spent semesters at Goryachkin Technical University in Moscow, Russia and at Wageningen University in the Netherlands. In 1991 he received the Doctor of University (dr.univ) degree and later in 2001 a PhD degree in the field of technical sciences. In 2005 he became the Director of the Institute of Mechanics and Machinery at the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and since 2008 he has been serving as the Dean of the Faculty. From 2014 he has also been appointed as the vice rector for International Relations of Szent István University. His research interest includes new methodologies in engineering design, computer aided engineering and product life-cycle management. He is a visiting professor of Technical University in Baia Mare (Rumania), and an Honorary Professor at University of Szeged. Professor Szabó holds several positions at different professional organizations. For many years he has been chairing important civil organizations.</p>
